anything to do with us? Secause he is our alumnus hore! Gene Sarron (Government 1977) took a year off doing modeling while he was at UT. His father told him, "You need to go back to Law School. Son, I know a lot of fat, old, rich lawyors but I do not know ANY fat, old, rich fashion modds." Not long later, he went back to Austin to finish school 2. There was a time when winning a major football bowl game was not too difficult for us. On January 2, 2005 at 5:50 am (HKT), at least 35 alumni and students gathered in Wanchai to watch Toxas beating Michigan in the Rose Sowi game. The game was decided by a field goal scored in the last 2 seconds by Texas that brought the Rose Bowl trophy to 150 people (many taking annual leave or sick leave) supporting Texas and Southern California gathered at the American Club to watch the Rose Sowl game which was designated as the National Champiorship

Game for the 2005 season. In the end, Toxas won the Rese Sowl, two years in a row as a team not from either Sig Ton or Pac-12. This is the picture of the famous "Hi, How Are You" mural on West 21" Street. The frog on the mural is "termink the tenerest"

You: The Unfinished Album". The mural was painted in 1995 by Johnston himself, commissioned by the record store Sound Exchange which was there at that time. In 2004. Sais Fresh took over the building and the manager decided to remove the wall, but the people living in the neighborhood successfully convinced the manager to keep t. Election Flow

- Election Officer's Opening:
 - Announce start of election
 - Eligibility to vote: Members of HKTX (membership fee paid and unpaid) for more than 6 months
 - Each cabinet candidate to have up to 10 minutes to introduce itself, followed by up to 5 minutes of questions from the floor
 - All members and alumni may ask questions
 - Guests may not ask questions
 - Elected cabinet candidate will be Executive Committee from tomorrow (the day following the next AGM)
 - Introduction of President Candidates
 - Only one candidate, simple majority to confirm as Executive Committee according to 5.5.3 of the Constitution
 - If rejected, EGM will be held in 1 month
- Candidate presentation (< 10 minutes)
- Questions from floor (< 5 minutes)
- Vote
- Election officer to announce cabinet elected/confirmed/rejected as the Executive Committee of 2013-2014
- Newly elected President elect to give acceptance speech
